Reclaiming the Children



Nyamphande means a land of peace where there is good soil to grow food. Nyamphande Orphanage is located in the landlocked south-central African country of Zambia. It is in the “bush” about 40 miles from the city of Lusaka.

The people are mostly of Bantu origin. English is the official language, but Bemba is widely spoken.

Almost 90% of the population lives below the poverty level. Access to clean water is very limited. Proper health care is difficult to obtain.

The World Health Organization estimates the life expectancy at 30.8 years. Malaria is the #1 killer. The HIV/AIDS pandemic is rampant with 1.1 million Zambians currently infected.

Children Are the Most Vulnerable

According to UNAIDS, 650,000 children in Zambia have been orphaned by AIDS. By 2010, one out of every four Zambian children is expected to be orphaned.

Malnutrition remains a major cause of death and illness in children under five because of contaminated water and chronic food shortages. Resulting illnesses are ravaging Zambia’s most precious resource—its children.

Lack of education is a problem. The enrollment age for primary school is seven, however, many children are delayed in starting because families cannot afford the cost. Many children must walk alone for long distances to get to school.

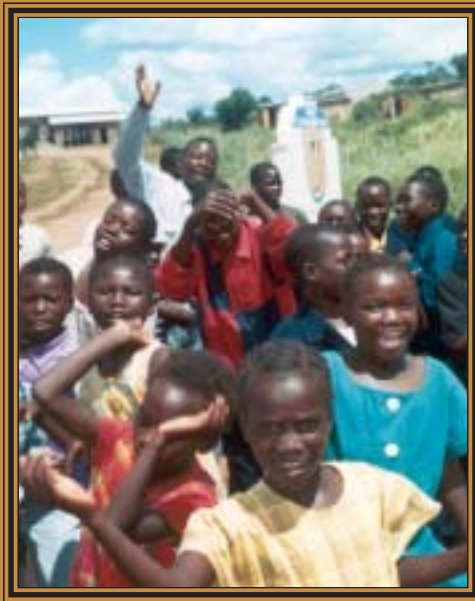
